Mid-Carolina Electric Cooperative Board compensation and expenses January-December 2021, Audited

SECTION 33-8-101 of the South Carolina code of Laws requires: "all corporate powers must be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of a corporation must be managed under the direction of, a board of directors." Section 1, Article IV of MCEC's By-Laws requires: "The business and affairs of the cooperative shall be managed by a Board of nine (9) members which shall exercise all of the powers of the Cooperative except such as are by law, the articles of incorporation or these Bylaws conferred upon or reserved to the members."

MCEC has a written policy regarding payment, reimbursement or provision of expenses. It requires substantiation prior to expenses being incurred or reimbursed. Per diem (per day) payment is \$550 for attendance at regularly scheduled board meetings. Per diem (per day) payment is \$400 for attendance at other meetings. Per diem (per day) payment for teleconference meetings is \$175. To control cost, it is the customary practice of MCEC's Board to hold Committee meetings on the same day as regularly scheduled Board meetings. Board members also attend meetings such as the Annual Meeting & Member Advisory Committee meetings where they do not receive a per diem. Special board meetings are held in rare instances where official Board action is required between regular meetings and er typically held by teleconference. Co-op service organization meetings are attended in conjunction with MCEC's membership in these organizations. Training and certification meetings and classes are attended for Board members to obtain required credentials and for continuing education.
